ATOMIC BLAST: Summer Enrichment Program

Parents and Guardians:

We have an action packed summer planned for your child! Please read in detail.

Below is information about our summer enrichment program.

Program Duration- Cleveland Park Clubhouse, Andrew Jackson Clubhouse, and Preston Taylor Clubhouse: Tuesday, May 29, 2018 - Friday, July 27th, 2018.

Fees: Summer fees are \$50.00/per week/per child. There is an enrollment deposit of \$60 or \$85 per child to secure a space in the summer enrichment program.

*The fee includes breakfast, lunch, snack, summer enrichment programs and activities.

EARLY PAYMENT OPTIONS

Parents have the option of making payment in two ways:

1. Parents have the option of making a one-time payment of \$350.00, in addition to the required summer enrollment deposit, which will cover the cost of the entire summer enrichment program and the last week free. Payment **MUST** be received no later than May 18, 2018. Each one-time payment will receive a \$50 discount towards the **last week ONLY**, which will mean a total cost of \$400 for the entire camp per kid.
2. A two payment plan: \$200.00, in addition to the required summer enrollment deposit, which will cover the costs of the 1st half of the summer enrichment program from May 21st – June 29th (payment must be received by May 18th). The balance of \$175.00, which will cover the costs of the 2nd half of the summer enrichment program from July 2nd – July 27th (payment must be received by June 22nd). Payment **MUST** be received no later than the dates given above. Upon final payment, it will cover the cost of the entire summer enrichment program and the **last week ONLY half priced**, totaling \$425 for the entire camp per kid.

OR

Parents have the option of making weekly payments:

1. Weekly installments of \$50 per week, which will cover the cost of 1-week of the enrichment program. Payments are made before services are rendered. Payments are due on the Friday for the following week.

DHS Childcare certificates are accepted. Scholarships are available based on evidence of need.

*Boys & Girls Clubs of Middle Tennessee utilizes a Need-Based Rate Scale which is based on scholarship availability and evidence of need, however no child is denied service due to their inability to pay. Families participating in Families First or AFDC are encouraged to enroll their children. Donations from corporations, foundations, and joyful givers allow us to provide scholarship support to our Club members. Ask your Club Director for details.

Daily Schedule: Hours of Operation are from 7:00 am- 6:00 pm, Monday – Friday. The daily schedule for the Club is as follows (times may be adjusted based on Club needs):

AM Snack: 8-8:30am

Academic Enrichment: 8:30-11:30am

Lunch: 11:45-12:30pm

Health and Life Skills Activities: 1-6pm

PM Snack: 4-4:30pm

Enhancement Activities: 4:30-6pm

We recommend that members arrive around 8:30am to receive the full benefit of the enrichment portion of the program.

Club Calendar Check out the summer calendar! On it, you will find our field trips, special events, and reminders. The calendar will be posted at the front desk and will be provided at orientation.

Group Advancement- What “group” is my child going to be in this summer? This information is handy when picking up your children as well as deciding which trips to attend.

Dreamers: Ages 5-6

Believers: Ages 7-8

Achievers: Ages 9-10

Contenders: Ages 11-12

Leaders: Ages 13-18

- Note: If your child has a birthday in the summer, they will remain in the group that they started.

Field Trips: Please read in detail, as field trip information has changed this year! We have had to make these changes for several reasons: to stay in compliance with the Department of Education, to be more efficient with documentation, and to make transportation more affordable and effective. Major changes are noted in italics.

Parents must turn in all permission slips a week in advance. One name per slip is allowed. Permission slips will be available at the front desk for each trip. In order to get the permission slip, parents must have **cash** in hand. Payments for field trips will only be taken **Monday-Wednesday** for the following week of the trips. NOTE: Staff will not accept any field trip money on Thursday or Friday. *The bus will only hold up to 70 Club members, so trips are first-come, first served.*

Please remember all field trips need to be paid in **CASH ONLY**. Checks are not accepted. Money should be paid to the front desk attendant.

Field Trip T-shirts: *This summer, field trip t-shirts are mandatory to attend.* Field trip shirts allow us to identify members easily and keep them safe. These shirts are \$10.00 per child.

Field Trip Money Holders: Staff cannot be held accountable for holding your child’s money for field trips. Please have them wear bottoms with pockets.

Parent Meetings: Mark Your Calendars to join us for our mandatory parent meeting. See your Club Directors for future dates. In this meeting, we will cover our parent handbook, and address any issues parents may have.
